

PICKING UP AND DROPPING OFF CHILDREN

Our commitment

Our association is committed to providing a safe environment for the participation of children and young people. Part of this is ensuring that children and young people are not left alone after practice or games.

What we will do for AICES Teams

- Make sure school/parents/guardians and children know the time and location of practice and games and when they should drop and can expect to collect their children.
- Request coaches and other sporting personnel to arrive at least 30mins before scheduled practice or game times.
- Supply coaches a register of parent/guardian emergency contact numbers and make sure they have access to a phone.
- Ensure that if parents/guardians are late, coaches will try to make contact with them and:
 - ask the second to last child and their parent/ guardian to wait with the coach/official and the child
 - avoid transporting children to their homes unless permission has been given by parents/guardians.

What we ask Parents/Care Providers to do

- Drop off and pick your children up on time or make other arrangements.
- Inform the coach about any changes in arrangements for picking up your child.

Sub Association & Parents Duty of Care

 Where AICES is holding a trial or carnival where the AICES Sub Associations are present, it is the Sub Association and or Parents who are responsible for their own students. Sub Associations should follow their own association's policies on Drop Off and Pick Up. AICES will not provide supervision for Sub Association or individual students at AICES Trials or Events.
