- * Each team must supply their own scorer (level 1 or 2).
- * Games last for 1hr and 15 minutes or 7 innings.
- * A DR (designated runner) may be used.
- * As it is a trial there will be runners on base as follows:
 - 1st innings = none
 - 2nd innings = runner on 1
 - 3rd inning = runner on 2
 - 4-7 innings repeat 1st to 3rd innings pattern
- * Pitching distance 43ft
- * 7 runs over the plate in each innings
- * Catcher speed up rule will be enforced

These players will participate in the AICES Training Day and then the CIS Softball Carnival in Term 1 2022.

Selections

Each association must supply one selector. Selectors will meet briefly at the end of each round. Selectors will choose two even teams to play off to finalise selections.
