LEVELS OF HOW PROTESTS, DISCIPLINE AND DISPUTES ARE TO BE HANDLED AT AICES TRIALS AND CARNIVALS

Team Trials

Level 1 Referee/Umpire

Level 2 Teachers in Charge of the team activity from both associations.

Level 3 A Disputes and Discipline PANEL will be established including:

AICES EO

Convenor of that sport

A school Head of Sport (not associated with the dispute)

Swimming, Athletics, Cross Country Carnivals

- A Protest Form must be lodged with the Carnival Manager within 30 minutes of the event finishing.
- A committee consisting of the following will deal with the protest:
 - Carnival Manager
 - NSW Official
 - Any Head of Association (not involved with the protest)

At a later date:

Level 4 AICES Disputes Committee in conjunction with members of the Disputes and Discipline Panel established on the day. The AICES Disputes Committee will be comprised of any three Association Convenors not involved in the dispute. The committee will recommend a sanction (if any).

Level 5 AICES EXECUTIVE OFFICER

The AICES Executive Officer cannot over rule the AICES Disputes and Discipline Committee decision on a particular issue but can inform and discuss with the Committee, changes of approach for future events.
